

**LEPC District VI – East Central Florida
Biennial Exercise Requirement 2008-2009**

Exercise Date: December 9th, 2008
Exercise Location: Kissimmee Civic Center

Scenario Summary:

CAI in conjunction with CSX Transportation is working with the District VI LEPC for this year's exercise. The scenario includes a train incident resulting in the release of hazardous materials.

A CSX train is traveling in Osceola County. The train derails in Kissimmee, Florida at a specific site to be revealed at the exercise. The cause of the derailment is currently unknown. A number of derailed tanks are piled up and there are indications that several are leaking and/or spilled their contents. Preliminary reports indicate one of the spilled chemicals is anhydrous ammonia.

Establish a Public Information System
Develop an incident action plan (IAP)

Discuss/implement Onsite Incident Management
Discuss/implement Citizen Evacuation and Shelter-in-Place
Discuss/implement Hazardous Materials Response and Decontamination
Discuss/implement Emergency Public Information and Warning
